The *Ellen Woodnick Mitzvah Mall* is a project intended to promote *G'milut Chasadim* (Acts of Loving Kindness) within our community and to provide a meaningful holiday gift-giving alternative for our students and families.

The *Mitzvah Mall* is a fair of non-profit organizations that promotes charitable giving. It is similar to a vendor fair. Every student in our school and many temple congregants come to the *Mitzvah Mall* to shop among the charities that are represented at different stations. At each station, donations for a particular charity may be purchased in amounts ranging from \$1 to \$25 in exchange for a certificate stating how the donated money will be used by that organization. The certificate can then be personalized and given as a gift.

STEP 1:

Talk with your child(ren) about whom they would like to honor this holiday season with a personalized donation certificate (teachers, grandparents, friends, etc).

STEP 2:

Go through this packet and see which donations you would like to purchase in honor of someone and in exchange for donation certificates.

STEP 3:

Fill out the *Mitzvah Mall Donation Form* (attached to this packet) with your family and then bring it with you when you join your child(ren) at school on Dec 11th during our Chanukkah Family B'yachad to make donations and purchase certificates so your child can participate in this mitzvah.

STEP 4:

Personalize your certificates and give them to those you would like to honor.

The Mitzvah Mall is named in memory of Ellen Woodnick,
a beloved 4th grade teacher at Temple Chai.

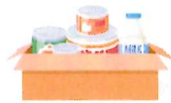

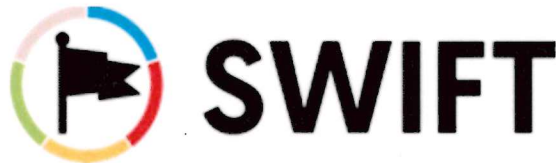
