Prayer Lab - An Experiential Service

Our Prayer Lab service is for those who want to delve more deeply into the High Holy Day experience. We will take the powerful themes of these important days "off the bimah," and put them into your hands for personal contemplation and inspiration. It will be welcoming for beginners and thought-provoking for those already comfortable with prayer. Though not a family service, children are always welcome.

Family/Multi-Generational Service
